RESPECT CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS / CARERS & SPECTATORS

At Montagu and North Fenham FC we all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game. This club is supporting The FA's Respect programme to ensure football can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment. Remember children's football is a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical and social skills. Winning isn't everything. Play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct for parents / carers and spectators at all times.

I will:

- Remember that children play for FUN.
- Applaud effort and good play by players of both teams.
- Always respect the match officials' decisions.
- Remain outside the field of play and within the designated spectators area (where provided). Never enter the field of play during a game.
- Let the coach / manager do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do and / or being critical of the coach / manager.
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee, and match officials.
- Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake mistakes are part of learning.
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour.
- Pay subscriptions as directed by the club and adhere to the subscriptions policy.
- Support and encourage your child in adhering to the Respect Code of Conduct for Youth Players.

I understand that if i do not follow the Code, any / all of the following actions may be taken by my Club, County FA, League or The FA.

I may be:

- Issued with a verbal or written warning from a club or league official.
- Required to meet with the Club, League or CFA Welfare Officer.
- Required to meet with the club committee.
- Obliged to undertake an FA Education Course.
- Obliged to leave the match venue by the club.
- Requested by the club not to attend future games.
- Suspend or have my club membership removed.
- Required to leave the club along with any dependants.

In addition:

• The FA / County FA could impose a fine and suspension against my club. Players are liable to pay their own fines and all administration costs imposed by both the appropriate league and the Football Association (FA). Players with outstanding fines will not be allowed to play in matches.

Montagu and North Fenham FC expect all parents / carers & spectators to:

- Promote the club in a positive manner.
- Assist the coach / manager whenever possible and help reinforce their principles.
- Set a good example to the whole team by your words and actions.
