RESPECT CODE OF CONDUCT FOR YOUTH PLAYERS

At Montagu and North Fenham FC we all have a responsibility to promote respect and high standards of behaviour in the game. As a player, you are expected to be a big part of this. Montagu and North Fenham FC and the FA request every player to follow a Respect Code of Conduct.

As a player I will:

- Always try to play to the best of my ability.
- Play fairly - this includes not cheating, complaining or wasting time.
- Respect my teammates, the other team, the referee and my coach / manager.
- Play within the rules of the game, which will be directed by the referee.
- At the end of each game, shake hands with the other team and referee.
- Listen to what my coach / manager tells me.
- If I'm unhappy about anything at my club i will discuss this with my coach / manager or club welfare officer.

I understand that if i do not follow the Code, any / all of the following actions may be taken by my Club, County FA or The FA.

I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team mates, the other team, referee or team manager.
- Receive a formal warning from the coach / manager or the club committee.
- Be dropped or substituted for games.
- Be suspended from training.
- Be required to leave the club.

In addition:

My Club, County FA or The FA may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct.

The FA / County FA could impose a fine or suspension against my club. Players are liable to pay their own fines and all administration costs imposed by both the appropriate league and the Football Association (FA). Players with outstanding fines will not be allowed to play in matches.

As a member of Montagu and North Fenham FC you will:

- Pay regular subscriptions set by the Manager Committee.
- Take care of any kit / equipment provided and replace any lost or damaged items. Players will be liable for repair and replacement of any damaged kit at the discretion of the team manager.
- Behave appropriately when representing the Club.
- All players should attend training sessions and matches and arrive at the agreed time as specified by the team manager / coach.
- Give your manager sufficient notice (24 hours) if you are unable to train or play in matches.
- Wear the correct kit for the conditions and ensure shin guards are worn at training and matches.
- Return all kit and equipment and ensure subscriptions are fully paid if i leave the club. Failure to return all kit when a player leaves the Club will result in reporting the player to the Northumberland FA. It should be noted that affiliated clubs will not allow players to play whilst this issue is outstanding.
